# **International Chess Festival**

# 12th to 19th February 2022 - Rasht, Gilan, IRAN

#### **Invitation**

This is the official invitation for participation in the "19<sup>th</sup> Caspian Cup" which will be held in *Rasht, Gilan, Iran*, from 11<sup>th</sup> of February (arrival) till 19<sup>th</sup> of February (departure) 2022. The competition will be organised and held by Gilan Chess Association under the auspices of Chess Federation of I.R.IRAN.

### 1. General Regulations & Rules

**1.1** The Tournament shall be governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Competition Rules.

## 2. Participation

- **2.1** The categories are as below:
  - Category A Master tournament- for Masters (GM, IM, WGM and WIM) and players with Rating 2200 and higher.
  - Category B for players with Rating less than 2200 and 1800 and higher.
  - Category C for players with Rating less than 1800.
  - Category D for Women.
  - Category E for cadets & youth players under 14 years old (Born on or after 1 January 2008)
- 2.2 The tournaments are open to all local chess players and foreign players who have FIDE ID.
- **2.3** Players born on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2008 can participate in the E category.
- Under 8: Born on or after 1 January 2014
- Under 10: Born on or after 1 January 2012
- Under 12: Born on or after 1 January 2010
- Under 14: Born on or after 1 January 2008
- +65: Born on 1957
- +50: Born on 1972

#### 3. Financial Regulations

- **a.** Entry Fee: The entry fee is free for GMs, IMs, WGMs.
- **b.** All other players must pay an entry fee of 50 EUR. to the organiser.













## 4. Playing Venue & Accommodation

- **4.1** The playing venue & official hotels are located in the Rasht.
- **4.2** Free full board accommodation for GMs and IMs will be provided by the organiser from 11<sup>th</sup> of February (arrival) till 19<sup>th</sup> of February (departure) 2022. (First Come First Served)
- **4.3** Free accommodation for the first registered player from each country will be provided by the organiser (Early Bird registration priority)
- **4.4** All participants and all accompany persons are obliged to lodge at the official Hotel. Bookings of official Hotel for the event should be done through the organisers only.

#### 5. Technical Regulations

- **5.1** Time control: Each player shall have 90 minutes with the addition of 30 seconds per move starting from the first move.
- **5.2** Each category shall be conducted in the Swiss System of 9 or 11 rounds, depending on number of participants. (150 participants and less be 9 rounds, 151 to 200 participants be 11 rounds and more than 200 participants be Baku Acceleration System.)
- **5.3** Default late time is 30 minutes.
- **5.4** The Pairings will be made using Swiss Manager program and shall be announced as soon as possible after each round finishes. Pairings will be published on the www.chess-results.com website.
- **5.5** During play, a player is forbidden to have any electronic device not specifically approved by the Chief arbiter in the playing venue.
- **5.6** A player may talk only to an arbiter, or with his opponent as permitted by the Laws of Chess.
- **5.7** During the playing session, players are not allowed to leave the playing venue without the permission of the Chief Arbiter.
- **5.8** Players cannot "informally" tell an arbiter that they suspect that another player is cheating. This also applies to any other person having a FIDE Identity Number. All cheating-related communications shall be duly recorded, and the arbiter should ask player to make an official In-Tournament complaint.
- **5.9** If players inform the Chief Arbiter to be absent in one round, they will be scored 0.5 (half-point bye). No player may request a half-point bye after round 5. **This option does not exist in Category A.**

#### 6. Tie-break System

**6.1** The final ranking order of the players is determined by the number of points scored. If at the end of the tournament two or more players are tied for the first place or for any prize, the tie shall be broken as in accordance to the following:

- **8.1** All prizes are in IRR (Iranian Rial)
- **8.2** 10% will be deducted from cash prizes.
- **8.3** Only one prize can be awarded to a player. (The highest prize)
- **8.4** If two or more players are tied, the tie-breaks systems will be used. (Prizes will not be shared)

#### 9. Appeals Committee

- **9.1** Protests against decisions of the Chief Arbiter or his assistants must be submitted in a written form to the Chairman of Appeals Committee within 15 minutes after the end of the game. The protest must be accompanied with the protest fee of 50 Euros. The fee must be handed to the Chairman of the Appeals Committee. If the appeal is upheld, the sum shall be returned immediately. If the appeal is refused, the fee is forfeited to organiser.
- **9.2** The decision of the Appeals Committee is final, binding and takes effect immediately.

#### 10. Visa and Covid 19:

- **10.1** All players and accompanying persons who require a visa to enter Iran, must send a Scan of their passport (page with photo and key information) to the Organiser before the deadline of 10<sup>st</sup> January 2022.
- **10.2** According to the new guidelines issued by the National Corona Headquarters, visa applicants must meet the following conditions:
- \* Having a negative corona PCR test up to 72 hours before travel (for people over 12 years old)
- \* Have a vaccine card for every 2 doses
- \* The vaccine approved by Iran is approved
- \* The applicant is not from high-risk countries or his next destination is not high-risk countries













#### 11. Travel Information

- **11.1** All participants arriving by international flights should take plane to Imam Khomeini International Airport (IKA), Tehran, Iran.
- **11.2** The host federation will arrange the transportation from airport to the hotel for arrival and departure during the schedule dates.

#### 12. Health Protocols and Covid19:

- \* Providing Covid 19 vaccination card (by receiving at least 2 doses of valid vaccines) for all players over 18 years old, referees and executives of the tournament and also providing Covid 19 vaccination card (by receiving 1 dose of valid vaccines) for all players below 18 years and over 12 years are required. Registration and admission of players who do not have a Covid 19 vaccination card will be canceled and their entry fee will not be refunded.
- \* Masks are required for all participants, referees and executives throughout the game.
- \* The organizer can ask all players to submit a negative PCR test if necessary.
- \* If a player has symptoms of a cold (Covid 19), he will be quarantined by the medical team stationed at the venue and will not be able to participate in the Covid 19 test until the result is determined.
- \* If it is found that a player has the symptoms of Covid 19 and has not informed the organizers, he will be expelled from the tournament and will be dealt with in accordance with the disciplinary regulations of the Chess Federation.
- \* Before entering the hall, all players, referees and executives will have a fever test.
